Gate prices apply once Fair opens February 10.

Complimentary off-site park and ride shuttle service is available on weekends. Guests may park at Highland Oaks (I-75 at Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd. exit), and take a free shuttle to the Fair on both Saturdays and Sundays. Runs continuously 9:00am to midnight both Fair weekends.
