

PHOTOGRAPHY COMPETITION (ADULT)

Entry Fee: \$2.00 per Adult entered item, No Entry Fee for Youth

ENTRY FORM DEADLINE: 5:00 PM, December 15, 2011

Dates for accepting items are Thursday, January 19, 2012, 10:30 AM - 6:00 PM; Friday January 20, 2012, 10:30 AM - 6:00 PM; and Saturday January 21, 2012, 10:30 AM - 4:00 PM.

Entries must be picked up on Tuesday, February 21, 2012, and Wednesday February 22, 2012, 11:00 AM - 6:00 PM.

The Florida State Fair Photography Competition is open to all Adult Photographers who are willing to comply with the following rules.

SPECIAL RULES

1. All entered items must be exposures made since January 1, 2011.
2. Only one print will be accepted in each class, as an exhibitor cannot compete against himself. If more than one entered item is received from the same exhibitor for any one class; all items entered from that exhibitor for that class will be disqualified by the judges. Because of the limitations of the space for display an overall of total of four (4) photographs per person will be accepted for judging.
3. All entered items must be securely mounted on standard single weight black or white matt board (no double matting) to the specified outer dimensions of 11" x 14" with a thickness not to exceed 1/16th inches. No hangers, no foam core mounts, no masonite mounts, no cardboard or scotch taped items will be allowed to compete. This rule is to protect your artwork. You have spent a considerable amount of time in capturing the image and making the competition print, taking pride in protecting it should be of the utmost importance to you. Any entered item not complying with these specifications will be disqualified by the judges and not displayed. Ask your processing lab to dry mount your entered item(s) to the specifications outlined.
4. Print size(s) shall be no smaller than 8" x 10", and no larger than 11" x 14". Any print that does not fit within this size limitation will be disqualified. Finished size must be 11" x 14".
5. In keeping with the Florida State Fair's family orientation; items of an offensive, controversial or objectionable nature or subject matter will not be accepted.
6. Entered items being mailed must be sent in standard photography cases or stiff cardboard suitable for mailing. Any damage caused by improper packaging will be at the exhibitor's expense. The Florida State Fair will not be liable for mail damage.
7. Exhibitor's name and address must be clearly printed on each print and case.
8. For return of photographs by mail refer to General Rules.

JUDGING

Judges will be looking for mastery of the medium, sharpness, exposure, print contrast, general artistic and aesthetic value in all divisions and classes.
