No Entry Fee for Adult or Youth

ENTRY FORM DEADLINE: 5:00 PM, December 15, 2011

Dates for accepting items are Friday February 27, 2012, 10:30 AM - 6:00 PM; and Saturday February 28, 2012, 10:00 AM - 3:00 PM.

Entries must be picked up on Tuesday, February 21, 2012, 11:00 AM - 6:00 PM.

SPECIAL RULES

1. All entered items submitted must have been completed after January 1, 2009. Work must be that of crafter exhibiting.
2. No more than two (2) entered items per class per exhibitor.
3. Entered items previously exhibited in the Florida State Fair may not be submitted for competition.
4. Entered items may be offered for sale at the option of the exhibitor; however, all entered items must remain intact until 11:00 a.m. Tuesday, February 22, 2011.
5. In the event the project overlaps two classes, the turner has the option of selecting the class for competition.

ENTERED ITEM REQUIREMENTS

1. Entered items will be accepted at the Florida Center from 10:30 a.m. until 6:00 p.m., Friday, January 27, 2012 and from 10:30 a.m. until 3:00p.m. Saturday, January 28, 2012. Please use the Orient Road entrance.
2. Entered items mailed or shipped to the Florida State Fair must arrive no later than Thursday, January 26, 2012. Mail entered items to the attention of Woodturning Competition using the address provided in the General Rules section.
3. Entered items delivered by hand may be picked up from 11:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, February 21, 2012. Entered items that were mailed in may be returned in the same manner. Please see the instructions given in the General Rules Section.

JUDGING

Design – 60%, Form, balance, weight, proportion, uniform wall thickness.

Finish – 40%, Lack of tool marks, scratches, etc. and appropriate finish material.

Judges reserve the right to decide proper classification. The decisions of the judge are final.

DIVISION 153A

Class Description

(HOLLOW VESSEL) Definition: Hollow vessel – a form with a top opening smaller than the width, containing substantial “hollow area.” Vase – a hollow vessel higher than wide

1. Standard **hollow vessel** or vase – may contain decoration while turning on the lathe (i.e. coves, beads, surface texture)
2. Embellished **hollow vessel** or vase – carved, fluted, wood burned, inlay, colored, etc.

(BOWL) Definition: Bowl – top opening larger than the base, exposing the interior to view. (Wider than high)

3. Standard **bowl** – may contain decoration applied while turning on the lathe (i.e. coves, beads, surface texture)
4. Embellished **bowl** – carved, fluted, wood burned, inlay, colored, etc.

(PLATE / PLATTER) Definition: Plate/platter – a form substantially wider than high with the surface open to view.

5. Standard **plate / platter** - may contain decoration while turning on the lathe (i.e. coves, beads, surface texture)
6. Embellished **plate / platter** - carved, fluted, wood burned, inlay, colored, etc.

(SPINDLE) Definition: Spindle – primarily turned between centers with grain parallel to lathe bed.

7. ALL SPINDLE – Primarily turned b/t centers, grain parallel to bed of lathe

(NATURAL EDGE)

8. ALL NATURAL EDGE
9. ALL SEGMENTED or constructed: pieced together and turned with one or more woods (e.g. maple/walnut)
10. OTHER THAN WOOD at least 50% other material (alabaster, plastics, metal spinning, soapstone, and combinations of above)
11. MINEATURE no dimension exceeding two (2) inches
12. ALL ORNAMENTAL (done with an ornamental type lathe)
13. LIDDED CONTAINER no dimension over 4”
14. LIDDED CONTIANER any dimension over 4”
15. OTHER jewelry, toys, pens, Christmas ornaments, utensils, constructed multiple turnings, resulting in spinning wheels, ships, wheel clocks, candelabra, reassembled turnings, wood or non-woods acceptable; however, 50% of project must be turned.
